**Re: Sex Establishment Licence Application (Shop): Eva Amour, 6 St Anne's Square, High Street, Barmouth, LL42 1DL.**

Please accept this email as an official letter of observation with regard to the above mentioned licence application following a large number of objections being raised within the community that we represent. The number of objection letters that we are aware of far exceeds any licence application that we have discussed in previous times.

Making reference to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982, Schedule 3, Section 12 (3) (i) and (ii)

*that the grant or renewal of the licence would be inappropriate, having regard*

- (i) to the character of the relevant locality; or*
- (ii) to the use to which any premises in the vicinity are put;*

Barmouth Town Council wishes to file an objection under these two points due to the location of the premises that the application is related to. The premises are adjacent to a pedestrian crossing where, during the high season, there are often a number of pedestrians waiting on the pavement area. In addition, Christ Church Presbyterian Church is situated opposite the premises. This is an active church with a regular congregation at their services.

We hope that these points will be strongly considered at the point of decision making.
