IT STARTS AT off the County Road (Penrhos-Caerffos) at Bryn Ceris and entering the County Council Trunk Road T.R.81 by Glyn Ceris, then off the main road and proceeding along the road to Treborth Farm and through the Farm Yard on to the Treborth Tube road and under the Railway Bridge and then over a stile to the field alongside of the Brittannia Tubular Bridge right down to the shore of the Manai Straits.

Condition:- Good, although there is no trace of the path from Treborth Uchaf to Treborth today it must have been ploughed but there are kissing gates at each end.
